Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.692 dated 12.08.2016 under Sections 302, 307, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Surender Singh states that out of 25 prosecution witnesses, 10 witnesses have been examined, whereas 02 witnesses have been given up and the case is now fixed for 22.11.2018 for remaining prosecution evidence.

Considering the serious allegations against the petitioner, no ground to grant bail is made out.
