In the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioners have sought for regular bail in case FIR No.32 dated 23.02.2018, under Sections 392/395/342/457/380 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bagha Purana, Moga.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that co-accused has been extended the benefit of regular bail on 10.05.2018 vide Annexure P-2. Therefore, petitioner is also entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned with the following conditions:-

- (i) Petitioners shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
- (ii) Petitioners shall also appear before the Station House Officer concerned on last Saturday of every month at 10.00 a.m. and mark their presence.
