Petitioner-Ajay Sharma alias Pandit has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.336 dated 05.09.2017, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 307 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and injured-Ravinder Singh has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR and stated to be armed with iron rod. Only simple injuries with blunt weapon are attributed to him. He is not the main accused.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 02.11.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
