The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.241 dated 30.11.2017, registered under Sections 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

It is allegation against the petitioner that 10 injections of Buprenorphine 10 ml each and 08 grams heroin/smack were recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Parshotam Singh, has submitted that the forensic science laboratory report has not been received and the same is still awaited. He has no objection if interim bail is granted to the petitioner.

Keeping in view these circumstances, the petitioner is ordered

to be released on interim bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. However, after receipt of forensic science laboratory report, trial Court shall decide as to whether the petitioner is entitled to regular bail or not.

Disposed of accordingly.
