The petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 186 dated 06.08.2015 registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, Amritsar under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

After his arrest, interim bail was granted to the petitioner because report of the chemical examiner had not been received. The petitioner failed to appear before the trial Court after receipt of report of the chemical examiner and, thus, he was declared as Proclaimed Offender.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 05.09.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail. In case such an application is filed, the same shall be decided expeditiously and not later than two days from the date of filing.
