In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.62, dated 17.04.2015, under Sections 380, 342, 458, 459, 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for more than a year, since 12.02.2017.

3. There is no direct material available against the petitioner, except for the disclosure statements of the co-accused persons.
