Petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuing direction to the respondents not to arrest him if any case is registered against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police officers are coming to the residence of the petitioner relating to a complaint filed by one Sukhdeep Singh. Petitioner is apprehending threat and there is likelihood that petitioner can be arrested without giving any notice in relation to that complaint. Petitioner has also made a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana but no action has been taken so far.

On asking of the Court, Mr. C. L. Pawar, Senior DAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Three copies of petition be supplied to him during course of the day.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 that in case the petitioner is required or involved in view of allegations made in the complaint against him, an advance notice of 7 days be given to him.
