The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.202 dated 06.07.2018 under Sections 8, 13(3) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015, Police Station Hathin District Palwal.

The allegations in nut-shell are that pursuant to receipt of the secret information, the petitioner was apprehended and was found in possession of 40-50 kilograms of cow meat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and that in any case, he has since joined investigation and he is no longer required for investigation and in these circumstances he deserves the concession of anticipatory bail.

On the other hand while opposing the petition, learned State

counsel has however informed that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find that it is a case of custodial interrogation. Accordingly the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 28.08.2018 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is accepted in the above mentioned terms.
