In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.209 dated 21.09.2007, under Sections 302, 307, 323, 324, 148, 149, 201 IPC read with offence under Section 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that crux of the matter in not extending regular bail to the petitioner is that petitioner has failed to furnish gun in the Gun House, Talwandi. During pendency of this petition, it is stated that gun which is required to be recovered is stated to have been remitted in the Gun House, Talwandi. Therefore, he is entitled for regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Jagjit Singh has not disputed the above fact.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that during pendency of this petition gun which is required to be recovered

is stated to have been remitted in the Gun House, Talwandi and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Amreek Singh alias Mela Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

8. Petition stands allowed.
