In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.79 dated 08.08.2018 registered under Sections 420, 471, 379, 411, 120-B IPC at Police Station City 1 Mansa, District Mansa.

2. Petitioner was granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 5.9.2018 and directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurbal Singh submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation pursuant to the order dated 5.9.2018 and he is not required for further interrogation.

4. Accordingly, order dated 5.9.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
