Petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.86 dated 30.11.2016 registered under Sections 458/427/506/148/149 IPC at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. The present FIR has been registered on account of some altercation and with the intervention of the respectable parties arrived at compromise.

3. Parties have entered into a compromise vide Annexure P-2. This Court by order dated 01.02.2018 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 17.2.2018 from which it is evident that compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion.

4. In view of the law laid down in Narinder Singh v. State of

Punjab; 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.86 dated 30.11.2016 registered under Sections 458/427/506/148/149 IPC at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur alongwith all consequential proceeding arising out of this FIR are hereby quashed subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.5000/- by each of the petitioner. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury, State of Punjab, within a period of 2 months from today.
