**Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)**

This petition is pending since the year 2015 i.e. for little less than three years for transfer of two cases i.e. one complaint No.RBT-83 dated 13.9.2013 (Annexure P1) registered under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 and one FIR case registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 406, 506 read with Section 34 IPC pending in the Court at Tohana, District Fatehabad to Kurukshetra Courts.

The allegations are that the respondent wife had attacked the petitioner husband on 29.1.2015 while attending the Court proceedings.

The case was adjourned from time to time.

Learned State counsel states that the complaint regarding said allegation was inquired by the police and it was found to be false. The dispute is between husband and wife and even if the case is transferred to some other Court, the same incident can again occur.

Considering that both the cases pertain to the year 2013 and 2014 and must be mature by now, there is no ground to transfer the aforesaid two cases.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
