Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the certified copy of the order dated 30.10.2018 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga indicating that the order dated 28.08.2018 passed by this Court has been complied with. Since the petitioner has already appeared before the learned trial Court, therefore, the order dated 16.04.2013 declaring him as a proclaimed person has lost significance and is rendered infructuous.
