Prayer in this petition is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 307 dated 25.05.2018 under Sections 379-A, 201 and 34 of IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR has been registered after the delay of four days of the alleged occurrence. The petitioner is in custody since 09.07.2018, despite that nothing has been recovered from the petitioner. Challan has already been filed. There is no other case pending against the petitioner. The trial is likely to take long time because even the charges have not been framed so far.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the charges have not been framed, so far or the fact that there is no recovery effected from the petitioner. Learned State counsel has not been able to controvert the fact that there is no case against the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered

to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
