Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the Registrar General of this Court to release the deposited amount of Rs. 30 lacs, which is lying deposited in FDR as per order dated 12.05.2016 passed in CRM-M-16251 of 2016, titled as Vivek Vedi and others vs. State of Haryana.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed the aforesaid petition with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail and this Court, vide order dated 12.05.2016, had directed the petitioners to deposit a sum of Rs. 30 lacs before the Registrar of this Court. Later on, vide order dated 16.02.2017, it was directed that an amount of Rs. 30 lacs deposited by the petitioners in the Registry of the Court, shall be kept in FDR, in a nationalised bank till the decision of the FIR case.

Mr. Naveen Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, as well as Mr. Sajjan Singh, Advocate, for the complainant have no objection for releasing the aforesaid amount in view of the fact that the FIR No. 133 dated 28.03.2016 qua the petitioners has been quashed vide order dated 06.02.2018 passed in CRM-M-39586-2017.

In view of the same, the Registrar General of this Court is directed to release the matured amount of Rs.30 lacs from the FDR and hand over the same by way of cheque/demand draft in favour of company, i.e. M/s Bigjo's Infrastate Limited through its Director Samir Jain or Siddharth Jain, as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioners, within a period of four weeks from today.
