The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short ' Cr.P.C.') for directing the respondents to comply with the provisions of Section 160 of Cr.P.C. before calling the petitioner to the police station regarding the alleged inquiry.

On instructions from ASI Hira Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that there is no inquiry pending against the petitioner at Police Station Division 6, Jalandhar.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to

be issued in the matter at this stage.

However, it is made clear that in case the presence of the petitioner is required in any inquiry by the police of Police Station Division-6, Jalandhar one week prior written notice be issued in terms of Section 160 of Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off in the above terms.
