The petitioner is aggrieved of order dated 13.07.2018 (Annexure P4), whereby his request for examination of hand-writing expert has been allowed only to the extent of examination of the disputed signatures on the cheque with the admitted signatures on record as well as order dated 26.07.2018 (Annexure P6), whereby application for correction of order dated 13.07.2018, has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner reiterates the arguments made before the learned trial Court.

While passing impugned order dated 13.07.2018 (Annexure P4), the learned trial Court has held that admitted signatures of the accused-petitioner are on record and therefore, it would be in the interest of justice, if the disputed signatures on the cheque are compared with the said admitted signatures. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to point out any error in this finding. In the order dated 26.07.2018 (Annexure P6), the learned trial Court has held that there was no clerical or arithmetical error in the order dated 13.07.2018,

and therefore, the application for correction of the same was mis-conceived. This finding has also not been assailed by the learned counsel for the petitioner in any satisfactory manner.

Thus, the present petition is mis-conceived and the same is dismissed.
