RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing of Rapat Roznamcha No. 21 dated 06.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 324/ 341/ 148/ 149 IPC and offence under Section 326 IPC added vide Rapat No.11 dated 09.07.2016, at Police Station Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala and its consequential proceedings in view of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Vide order dated 28.08.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks, to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Sub Divisional

Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi and got recorded their

statements qua compromise on 10.09.2018. Report from the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, vide letter No. 3528 dated 12.09.2018, duly forwarded by the office of District and Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide Endst. No. 1647 dated 13.09.2018, has been received. According to the report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, the matter has been voluntarily compromised between the parties with the free consent of complainant without any pressure or undue influence and the same is genuine.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony and peace in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid, Rapat Roznamcha No.21 dated 06.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner are quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/-, out of which `4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh; Rs.1,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs.5,000/- with the High Court Legal Services Authority, within a period of two weeks' from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
