The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to ensure protection from respondents No.5 to 7 or their relatives.

The allegations in the petition are that the petitioner intended to marry the daughter, namely, Arvinderdeep Kaur; of respondent No.5. However, the parents of the girl have fixed her marriage with somebody else. It is further contended that earlier the petitioner had filed the habeas corpus petition; in which the above said girl made a statement that she would like to marry the petitioner.

However, the order passed by the Court in the habeas corpus petition shows that the above said girl had made a specific statement that she was not under any illegal custody while she was with her parents. The document placed on record show that the said girl is now getting married with someone else. The petitioner has no locus standi to stop the marriage of the above said girl. The said girl has not come forward to allege that she was being married against her will now.

No document has been placed on record to show that the petitioner apprehends any threat at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7 unless he himself intends to disturb the marriage of the girl.

No ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
