In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.116 dated 12.03.2016 registered under Section 365 IPC at Police Station Gharaunda, Karnal and under Sections 420, 341, 302, 201, 120-B IPC (Added later).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that co-accused-Neelam has been extended the benefit of bail vide order dated 30.07.2018.

3. Learned State counsel submitted that petitioner has been implicated with reference to circumstantial evidence. It was also submitted that 6 witnesses have been examined out of 19 witnesses including the complainant.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances as also the fact that trial would take some more time for the purpose of examination of the witnesses, petitioner is entitled for regular bail. Hence, petitioner-Kuldeep @ Kala is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise

interfere with the fair trial.

6. Petition is allowed accordingly.
