Petitioners Shivani and Gurjant Singh have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1. The petitioners have annexed copies of their Aadhar Cards indicating that petitioner No.1 is aged 17 years, while petitioner No.2 is a little less than marriageable age of 21 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

Petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are stated to be less than 18 years and 21 years of age respectively.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) to look into the matter and to decide their representation dated 27.8.2018 (Annexure P-4) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties and shall not be deemed to confer any immunity upon petitioners from any action warranted under law for having married before the marriageable age.
