Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are adults and are in live in relationship for the last about 4 years. As a consequence of their long relations, petitioner No.1 gave birth to a female child from the loins of petitioner No.2. Since the petitioners are getting threats at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10, they moved a representation dated 24.08.2018 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Addl.

A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the above, without commenting anything upon the claim so projected by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 24.08.2018 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 to 10.
