The petitioner has filed the present revision for challenging the judgment and order dated 21/26.7.2004 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sirsa and judgment dated 15.3.2008 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa whereby he stood convicted under Sections 35-A and 35-D of the Wealth Tax Act and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment six months and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- on each of the two counts.

The revision stands admitted and the petitioner granted the concession of suspension of his sentence of imprisonment.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had apprised the Court that during the pendency of the revision, the petitioner had passed away. He, however, sought a short adjournment for producing the relevant material in this regard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced photocopy of the death certificate issued by the Registrar, Deaths and Births, Municipal Council, Sirsa, wherein it has been mentioned that the petitioner had passed away on 25.1.2016 and necessary entry in this regard made on 25.2.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that none of the near relatives of the petitioner has approached him seeking permission to continue with the revision.

In view of the above, the revision filed by the petitioner abates and disposed of accordingly.
