Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 618 dated 16.11.2017 under Sections 392, 397, 365, 347 of IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Sector-5, District Panchkula.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is concocted. The petitioner is not involved in any such crime as alleged in the FIR. It is further contended that even the complainant; while appearing as a witness before the Court below; has not fully supported in the case of the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 13.04.2018. Still further, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner was involved in another case also, however, in that case, as well, the petitioner is already on bail.

Counsel State counsel, being instructed by SI Ramesh Kumar, does not dispute the fact regarding the custody or the fact that the petitioner is on bail in another case, which was registered against the petitioner.

In view of the above submissions made by Senior counsel for

the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
