The petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take action against respondents No.4 to 7 on the basis of complaint dated 12.03.2013 (Anneuxre P-1) and enquiry report dated 24.04.2013 (Anneuxre P-2).

A perusal of the record reveals that parties are closely related. The petitioner got divorced from his wife and thereafter, he has been making allegations against his brother-in-law, who is respondent No.4. A perusal of the enquiry report dated 24.04.2013 (Anneuxre P-2) does not reveal the commission of any offence.

Thus, the present petition is misconceived and is dismissed.
