In the instant petition, petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.266 dated 09.08.2018 under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bhiwani.

2.) This Court vide order dated 29.08.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 29.08.2018, petitioner appeared before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and joined the

investigation. Petitioner is not co-operating in furnishing certain documents. When the petitioner is under suspension, question of furnishing documents relating to the school do not arise. Even assuming that petitioner has taken away such documents, necessary action be taken by the concerned police officials.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 29.08.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
