Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner Tayyab in a case arising from FIR No.148 dated 11.07.2018 under Sections 3/13(1), 8/13(3) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

According to the prosecution, on secret information, 386 skins were recovered from a pit dug by the petitioner in his house, out of whom 295 were declared fresh cow skins having fresh blood clots and tissues by Veterinary surgeon. The petitioner is also facing trial in another case of similar nature. According to the police, the petitioner ran away by jumping the wall of his house.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has wrongly been implicated. The petitioner was not apprehended at the spot. The age of the petitioner is 50 years. In such an advance age, it is impossible for a person to jump from a high wall. Therefore, the story introduced by the police is false.

In view of the totality of facts and circumstances, this Court does not find any merit in the instant petition, inasmuch as the petitioner is found repeatedly involved in business of cows slaughtering or trading of skins thereof.

Dismissed.
