The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.48 dated 05.08.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 295-A, 148, 149, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and later on added offence under Section 326 IPC at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

It has been submitted that only *lalkara* has been attributed to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 29.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
