The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.248 dated 02.10.2017, registered under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh.

An agreement was executed between petitioner-Amarinder Singh and complainant-Saleem with regard to sale of vehicle bearing registration No.CH02-3057. As per agreement, it was the complainant who has to pay the installment. Now petitioner has joined the investigation. Nothing is to be recovered from him.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 29.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
