In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.679 dated 22.09.2014, under Sections 392/506 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act (added later on), registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 24.10.2015. State counsel in their reply pointed out that petitioner is involved in number of cases for which this Court has directed the petitioner to file affidavit enclosing the relevant orders and it has been complied. Perusal of Annexures P-3 to P-9, it is evident that in each and every case, petitioner has been acquitted and it has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Papinder Singh.

3.) Heard.

4.) In the present case, trial stage is examination of prosecution witnesses. Trial proceedings would take some more time. Therefore, petitioner who is in custody since 24.10.2015 is entitled to regular bail.

5.) In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Manoj @ Vicky @ Monti is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned with the following condition:-

(i) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
