Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Manjeet Kaur and Tarsem Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.195 dated 15.08.2018 at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa under Sections 365/458/506/147/149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 29.08.2018 passed by this Court, both the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Naresh Kumar from Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa, who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 29.08.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
