The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for quashing of FIR No.135 dated 28.04.2014, under Section 324 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 11.09.2017, arrived at between the parties.

The previous order dated 24.04.2018, shows that the parties have not appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded qua the compromise relied upon by the petitioner. Therefore, it could not be said that the parties have compromised the matter as such. However, it is also recorded in the previous order and is submitted by the learned State counsel as well, that the police have already filed cancellation report regarding the FIR in question.

In view of the above, no further orders are required in this case.

The present petition is dismissed, while leaving the respective parties with liberty to avail their alternate remedies, in accordance with law qua the said cancellation report.
