By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.243 dated 22.10.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 427 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 29.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Akashdeep, Manjit Kaur, Sagar and Rajan as well as of complainant Akhil Sood have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. It has specifically been opined

by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.243 dated 22.10.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 427 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
