The petitioner has approached this Court by way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take action in accordance with law against respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The allegations in the petition are that respondent Nos.4 to 6 sold a piece of land to the petitioner without disclosing that the same had been mortgaged with a bank. The bank, accordingly, filed a suit against the petitioner for recovery of the loan amount. Thus, respondent Nos.4 to 6 have acted with fraudulent intention and appropriate action should be taken against them.

From the contents of the petition itself it is apparent that the loan has been repaid and that the mortgage has been redeemed. Even the suit filed by the bank has been dismissed. Thus, the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed. There is no occasion for this Court to exercise its power under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition has no merit and is accordingly, dismissed.
