Report dated 06.09.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Sri Anandpur Sahib has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Rajinder Kaur and the accused persons namely Amandeep Singh and Surjit Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.C-1 has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute and the fact that the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the settled proposition that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4)

RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.70 dated 20.06.2011 registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Roopnagar under Sections 406, 498-A IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
