GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.57 dated 15.7.2018 registered under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 29.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malout has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Jassa Singh, Vicky Singh @ Harjit Singh and Charanjit Kaur as well as of complainant Paramjit Kaur have been recorded to the

effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malout that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.57 dated 15.7.2018 registered under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
