By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.102 dated 31.10.2015 registered under Sections 307, 506, 427 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 30.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Gurwinder Singh @ Gurvinder Singh, Gurpreet Singh @ Kala and Makhan Singh as well as of complainant

Kulwinder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. It has specifically been opined by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.102 dated 31.10.2015 registered under Sections 307, 506, 427 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
