In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondent No.5 in terms of FIR No.133, dated 20.05.2017, under Sections 409/420/465/467/468 IPC, at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.
