GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.30 dated 29.03.2016 under Sections 420, 403, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station City 2, Abohar, District Fazilka and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 21.02.2018 the parties had been directed to

appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar has been received to the effect that the statements of complainant-Rishi Wadhwa and also of the petitioners/accused namely Inderjeet Singh Kalra and Gurpreet Singh @ Honey have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves out of their free will. Learned Magistrate has opined that the compromise so effected between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.30 dated 29.03.2016 under Sections 420, 403, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station City 2, Abohar, District Fazilka and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
