Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 05.08.2016 (Annexure P6) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide which the revision filed by respondent No.2, challenging the summoning order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P3), passed by the trial Court, was allowed and the matter was remanded back before the trial Court for passing a fresh order.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 submits that in pursuance to the remand order, respondent No. 2 has again been summoned by the trial Court under Sections 279 and 304-A of IPC and, therefore, this petition has become infructuous. Counsel for respondent No.2 has also placed on record photocopy of the summoning order dated 01.08.2017.

This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the same, this petition is rendered infructuous.
