Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner Harmanjit Singh in a case arising from FIR No.3 dated 17.01.2017 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station SSOC Amritsar, District Amritsar.

According to the prosecution, the petitioner along with his accomplices Harcharan Singh @ Harry, Anita, Daljit Singh @ Raja, Gurpreet Singh, Jaspal Singh, Udham Singh, Simran and Tajinder Singh are exploiting the unemployed youth of Punjab giving false assurance to them that they would be got recruited in Punjab Police and other Government departments by preparing fake documents and medical record also.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated. He has no role in the alleged commission of offence. He is ready to join investigation.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the case file, this Court is not inclined to grant any concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in view of the fact that exploiting unemployed youth on the false pretext of providing Government jobs is a very heinous crime. Therefore, this petition is dismissed.
