GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.155 dated 16.07.2018 under Sections 7(1), 10 of Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Area Act, 1975 and Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad.

The allegations in nut-shell are that the petitioner had carved out an unauthorized colony in village Dalelgarh, District Faridabad which is alleged to be falling within 5 kilometers of Urban Area of Faridabad.

Pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on 30.08.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation as has been as informed by learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Krishan Kumar.

Keeping in view the nature of allegations, it is a case which

is based solely on documentary evidence. The petitioner is not stated to be required for any further investigation. Accordingly the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 30.08.2018 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is accepted in the above mentioned terms.

It is, however, clarified that none of the observations made above shall be taken to be an expression on merits of the main case.
