Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.9611 dated 31.07.2017, registered at Police Station Irrigation and Power, Rewari, under Section 135 of the Electricity Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and respondent No.2 has also appeared through its counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to deposit the compounding amount of ₹50,000/- within ten days from today.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 01.02.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 01.02.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit the compounding amount of ₹50,000/- within ten days from today with the office of respondent No.2 failing which this petition shall be treated as dismissed. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
