The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No. 5 and for issuance of directions to restrain respondent No. 4 from harassing the petitioners in collusion with respondent No. 5

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amandeep S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondent No. 5 at this stage.

An FIR No. 100 dated 17.06.2017 has been registered against the petitioners under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural. The final report has not yet been prepared. It is further the contention that respondent No. 5 in collusion with respondent No. 4 is threatening the petitioners to involve them in a false case. In this regard a representation dated 08.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) has been submitted to respondent No. 2.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is

disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to look into the Representation (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
