GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 125 dated 26.8.2017, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC, Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 30.8.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Sarwan Singh and also of petitioners/accused Paramjit Singh @ Pamma, Satnam Singh, Gurnam Singh and Randhir Singh have been recorded to the effect that they

have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that he has no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. The learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala opined that the parties have entered into the compromise voluntarily, without there being any threat, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 125 dated 26.8.2017, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC, Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
