This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.23 dated 21.08.2016, registered under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code (offence under Section 120-B of IPC added later on) at Police Station Women Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, submits that the petitioner herein along with co-accused had preferred a petition bearing Crl. Misc. M-23300 of 2017 seeking quashing of the aforesaid FIR and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise entered into between the parties and in view of the compromise, all proceedings under

the aforesaid FIR had been quashed by an order dated October 30, 2017.

In view of the fact that all the proceedings under the instant FIR stands quashed, no further orders are called for in the present petition and the same stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
