The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.288 dated 12.12.2017 registered under Sections 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') Police Station City, District Kapurthala.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the contraband recovered from the petitioner was 10 Kgs of poppy husk, which was non-commercial quantity and there is no other case pending against him under NDPS Act, nor he is a previous convict.

The above factual position is not opposed by learned State counsel; rather duly acknowledged by him.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case,

without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Pritam Singh be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
