1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made to issue directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate the matter properly in case FIR No. 99 dated 08.08.2018 under Sections 307, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural is directed to decide representation dated 15.08.2018 (Annexure P-4), moved by the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural is directed to look into the matter and decide representation Annexure P-4, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
