This application has been moved for preponing of date in the main case which is fixed for hearing on 21.11.2018.

For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is allowed and the main case is taken up for hearing today itself i.e 31.10.2018.

CRM-M No.37871 of 2018

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.150 dated 27.06.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 of IPC (Section 326 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case due to party faction, whereas, he was not involved in the commission of offence. The alleged injuries are self inflicted just to falsely implicate the petitioner because of previous enmity.

Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and he is ready to join the

proceedings.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is only an accused and total four injuries have been caused with sharp edged weapon, out of which, two injuries have been declared as grievous in nature and because of that, the offence under Section 326 IPC has been added later on. Learned counsel also submits that three eye witnesses were present at the place of occurrence.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the contents of the FIR as well as other documents available on the file.

Keeping in view the nature of injuries and role of the petitioner being main accused and that the incident has been witnessed by three witnesses, no ground is made out to release him on anticipatory bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
