Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.747 dated 10.08.2017, registered at Police Station City Hisar, under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by complainant-Mangi Lal Sharma alleging therein that two boys came on a motor-cycle; that one of them was wearing

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helmet and another was in muffled face and that they had snatched a black bag from him which was containing ₹2 lakhs etc.

Complainant-Mangi Lal Sharma has already been examined in the Court, but he has failed to identify the present petitioner. Moreover, the petitioner has been in custody since 17.11.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
